DEGREE PROGRAMS

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

The Stuart School B.S.B.A. offers concentrations in entrepreneurship, finance, human resources, international business, and marketing that enable students to earn a degree that matches their career goals and aspirations.

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION AND APPLIED SCIENCE

The B.S.B.A. and Applied Science program provides students with the opportunity to combine their business education with concentrations in applied mathematics, chemistry, construction management, environmental management, information technology, life sciences, material sciences, or mechanical engineering.

GUARANTEED M.B.A. ADMISSION PROGRAM

Top incoming freshmen and transfer students can apply for guaranteed admission to the Stuart School of Business M.B.A. program concurrent with their undergraduate application. Upon completion of their undergraduate degrees, students have the choice of either entering the M.B.A. program immediately or deferring their admission for up to five years while they gain work experience.

BUSINESS HONORS LAW PROGRAM

Students qualifying with Advanced Placement credit who are accepted in the Business Honors Law Program have the possibility of accelerating the curricula in their B.S.B.A. and J.D. degrees, completing both programs in less than the standard seven-year timetable.
